

The Role of the Sport Chair

As a Sport Chair for the BC Games you are the link between the Host Community and your sport's Provincial Advisor. Within the BC Games Host Community organizational structure you will report to the Sport Directorate.

Your role includes:

- organizing all aspects of the sport competition
- attending meetings in the Host Community as required
- complying with all deadlines set by the Host Community Sport Directorate, your Provincial Advisor, and the BC Games Society
- participating in the Sport Venue Tour organized in your community approximately 3 months prior to the BC Games
- ensuring that sufficient local minor Officials, scorekeepers etc. are available during the Games
- consulting and communicating regularly with your Provincial Advisor
- preparing a final report upon completion of the Games

As Sport Chair you play a key in contributing to this successful community project. It will take approximately 2,500-4,000 volunteers from your local community working together to stage the BC Games.

While you may have significant experience in staging competitions for your sport, planning for the BC Games is different. You will have many people to assist you and what you do affects many others.
